BRITISH ANTARCTIC SURVEY IMMUNISATION REQUIREMENT

Jan 2013

The BASMU immunisation policy explains all the background as to why BASMU expect all staff deploying to Polar remote regions to have the following inoculations. Your GP will hold a record of your immunisation status and be able to provide the dates requested.

For everyone

Diptheria / Tetanus / Polio.

A combined vaccine. Booster every 10years up to maximum of 5 courses.

Meningitis ACWY

Single dose. Booster every 5 years to age 35.

MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)

A combined vaccine, one course.

For those who wish to have the vaccine (an individuals choice)

Yellow Fever

Recommended by the authorities who operate the Brize Norton (UK) – Ascension Island – Falkland Islands air route in case of aircraft diversion. Not mandatory, down to individual choice

NOT required for Arctic work.

For certain people as advised

BCG (Tuberculosis)

If screening information highlights this requirement.

Hepatitis A

For workers exposed to raw sewage.

Hepatitis B

For some health care workers.

Rabies

For staff travelling through high risk rabies areas on the way to and from Polar regions.
