
Seminar rooms

Hybrid



All our state-of-the-art spaces are fully optimised for hybrid events with a large display screen and video conferencing technology. The conference theatre is ideal for hybrid conferences with lectern, panel, lapel, handheld, throwable and ceiling microphones available, allowing flexibility for whoever is talking to be heard. There are also speaker, panel, room, handheld and manually positionable camera views so everyone can be seen by online guests.



We can also provide extension leads, ethernet connections and a BAS laptop for presentations. Guest wifi is available to all visitors and printing is available in moderate quantities. We can help with the set-up and familiarisation with the technology but the management through the event is the responsibility of the organiser. IT support is available if there are problems. Filming and photography at your event must be agreed beforehand and a formal agreement submitted.



Food and drink



In line with our ethos of environmental stewardship and sustainability, we have committed to serving low-carbon, vegetarian and vegan options. Carbon data is available for all our options.
